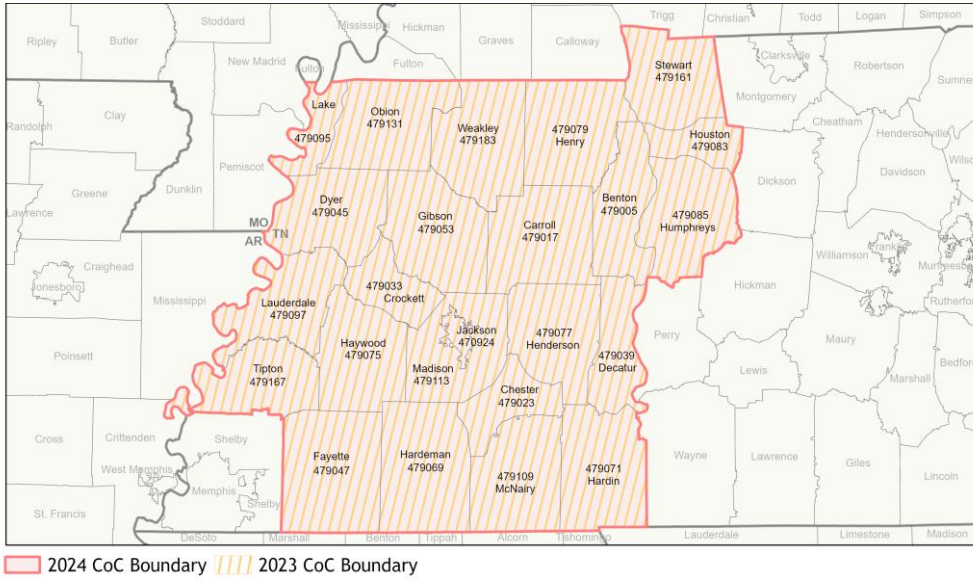
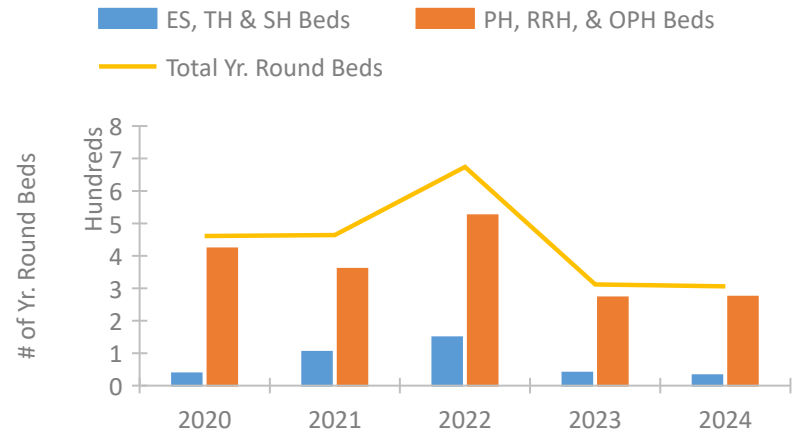

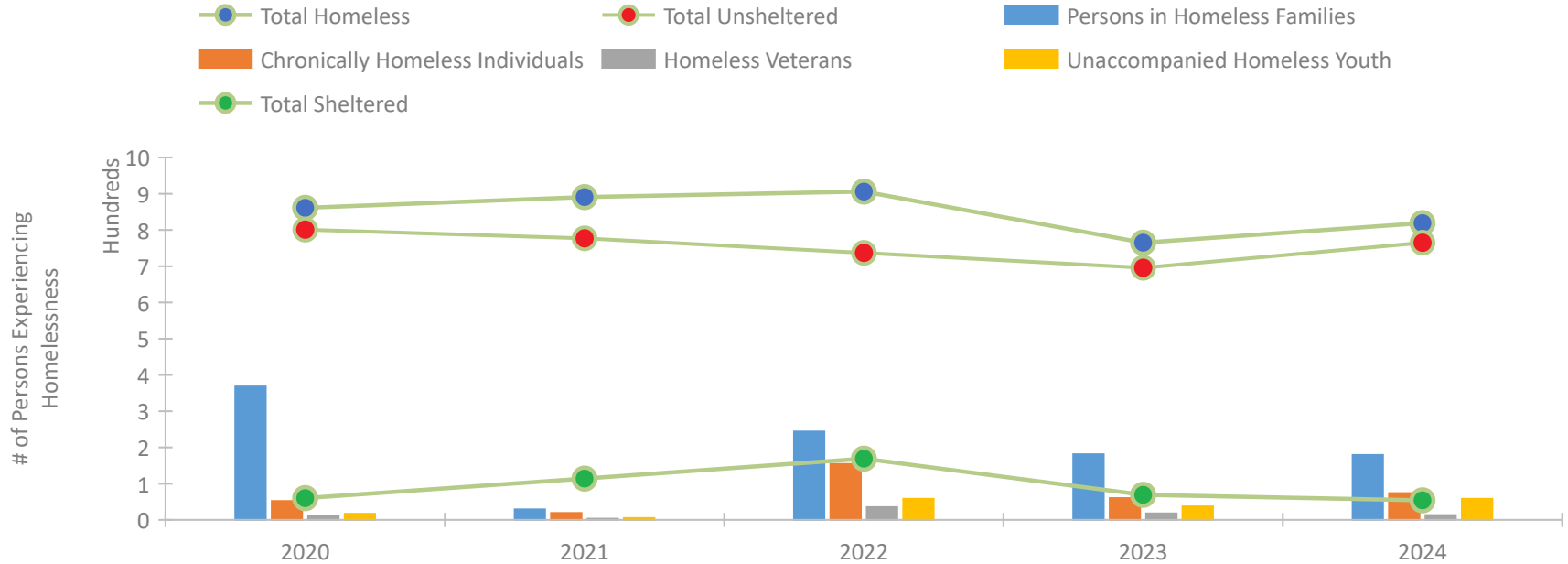
## Jackson/West Tennessee CoC



### Housing Inventory Count by Program Type



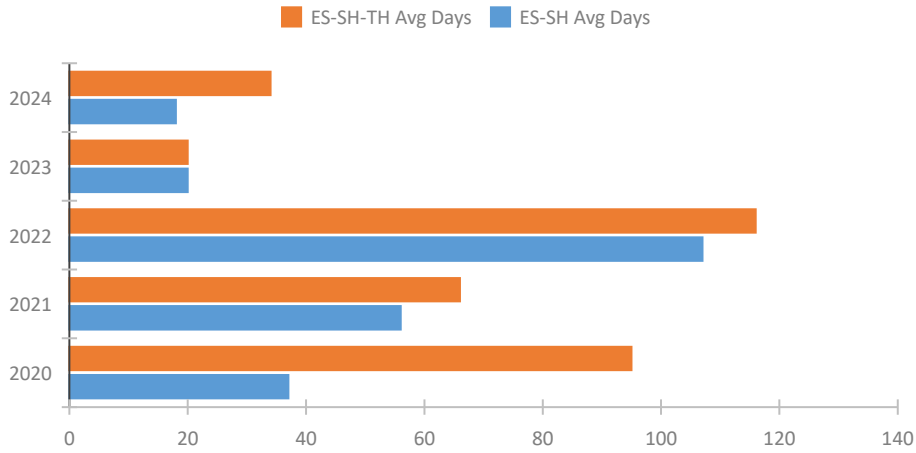
### Homeless Population – Point-in-Time (PIT) Count\*



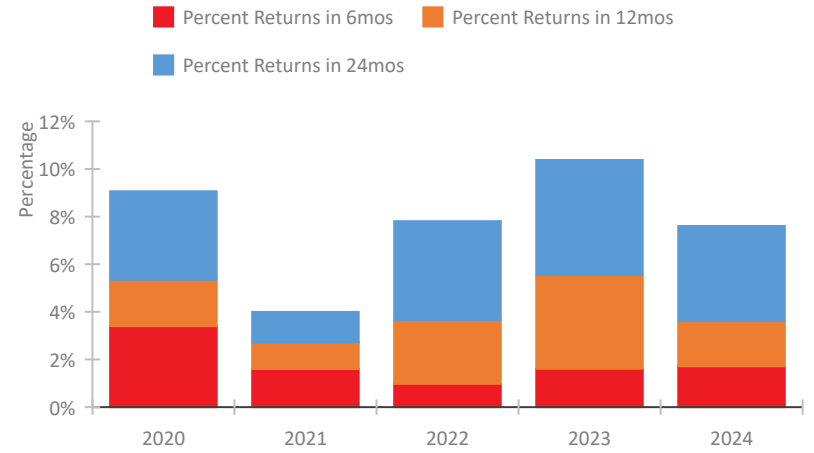

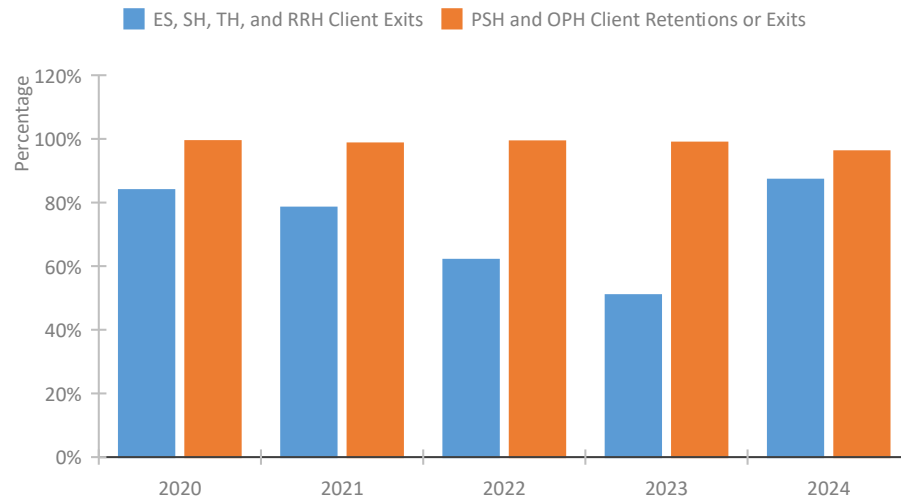
### Length of Time Homeless
