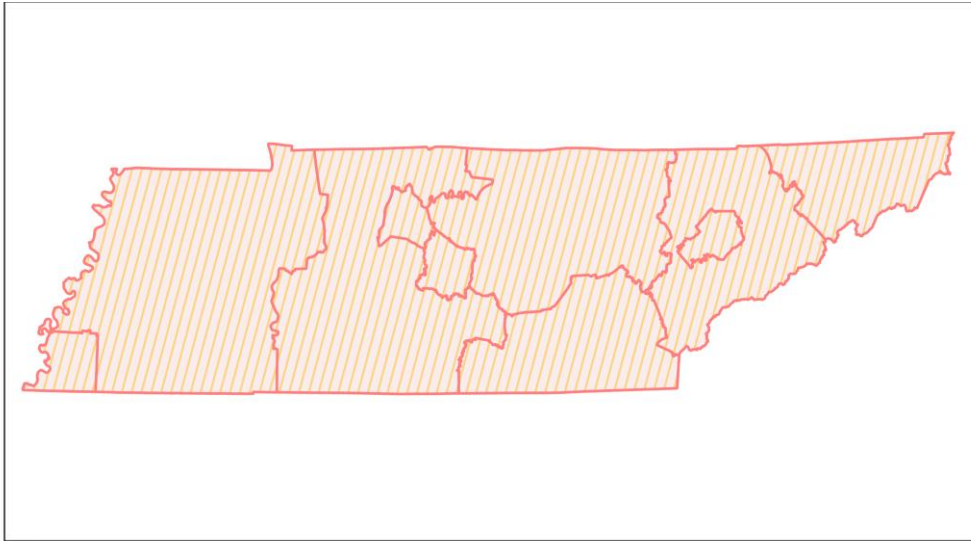
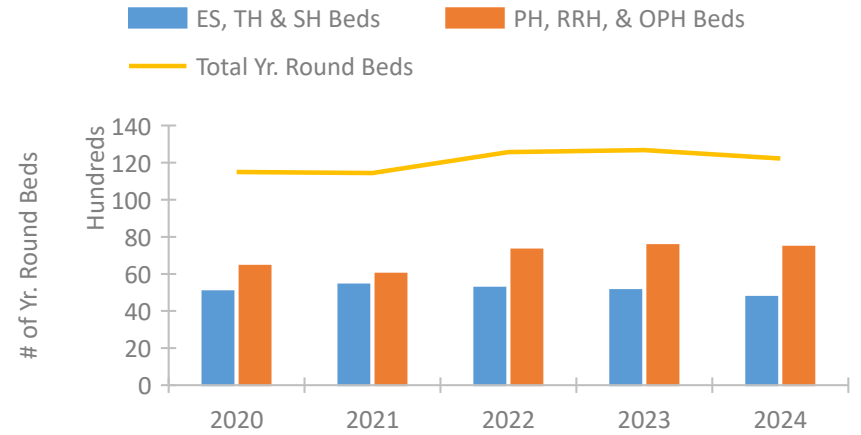


## Tennessee Continuum of Care Performance Profile

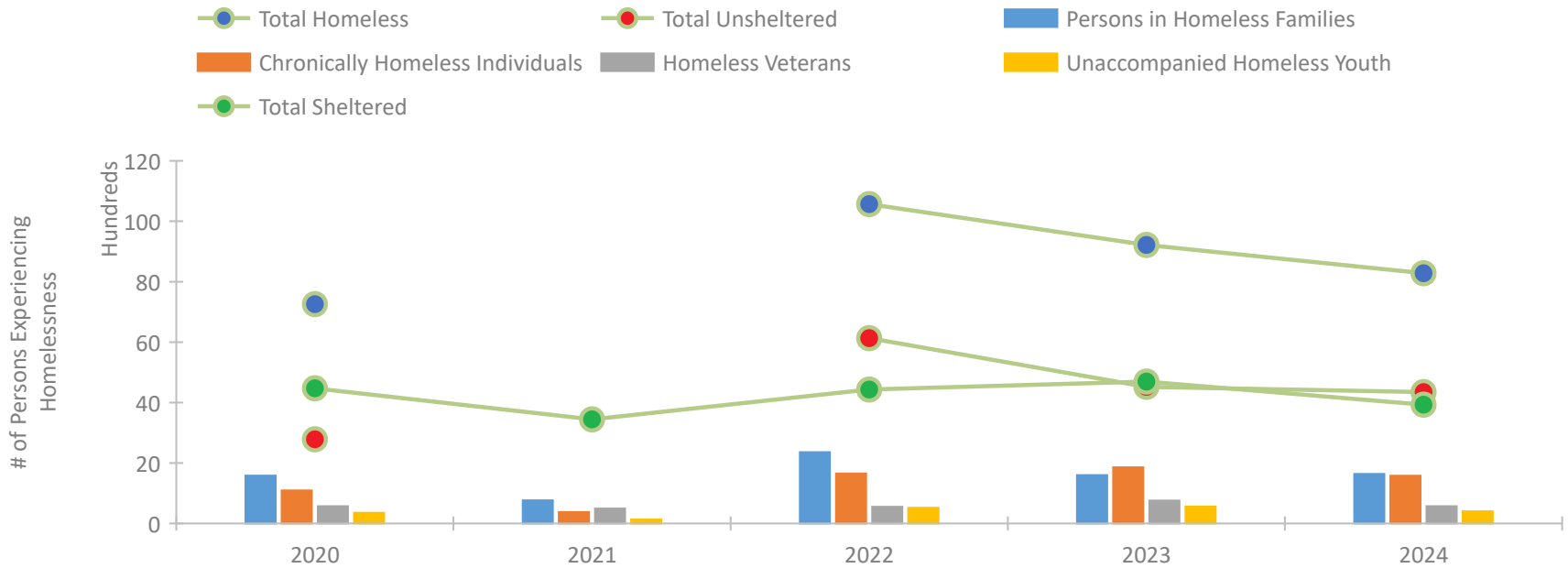


2024 CoC Boundaries 2023 CoC Boundaries

### Homeless Population – Point-in-Time (PIT) Count\*

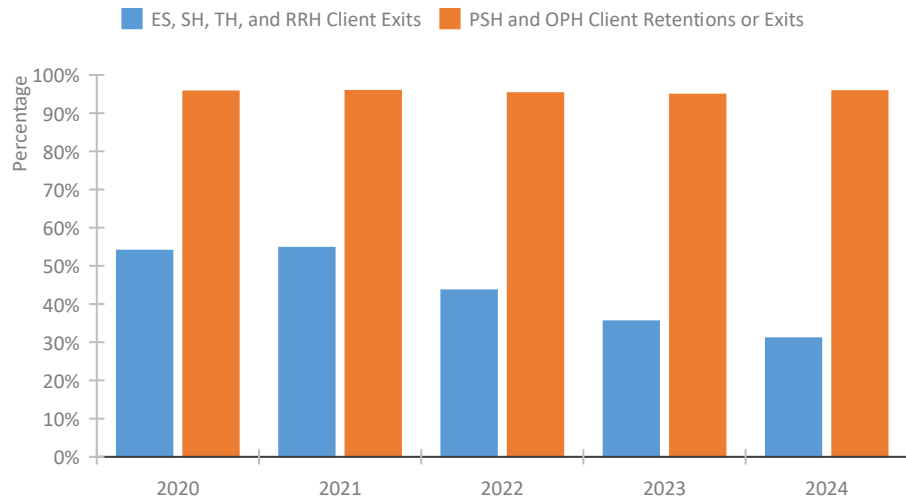

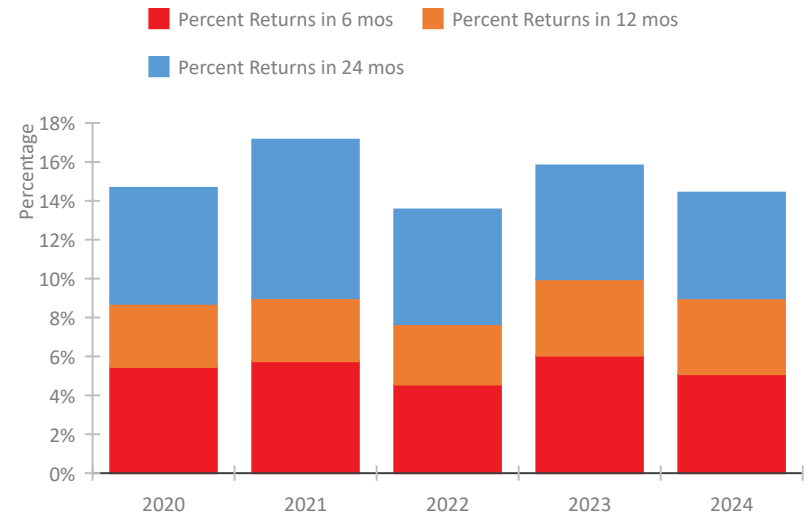
